- * 1969-Built and opened Dixie Speedway in Woodstock, Georgia.
- * 1971-Purchased then improved Douglasville Speedway into West Atlanta Speedway.
- * 1982-Built and opened Lanier National Speedway in Braselton, Georgia.
- * 1987-Won the prestigious "Auto Racing Promoter of the Year" award.
- * 2003-Inducted into the "National Dirt Late Model Hall of Fame."
